3. MINUTES OF MEETING HELD 13th June 2016

The minutes of the Monthly Parish Council meeting held 13th June 2016 were agreed to be a true record, proposed by Cllr G Woodfield, seconded by Cllr T Williamson.

4. POLICE REPORTS

PC Bailey advised the following by e-mail

"5th July 2016 – Ring O Bells – Dwelling Burglary

This was a sneak in type offence whilst the elderly occupant was in another part of the house, the suspect has walked into the kitchen and taken her purse from the kitchen side. When I write the next Roundabout article I will be mentioning this as a reminder to everyone to keep doors locked when in the house."

5. MATTERS ARISING

(a) Outstanding Items List:

(i) Works as per quote will be proceeding week commencing 18th July 2016

(ii) Helenship Lane Passing Places. Ongoing-await funding from Notts CC.

(iii) Alterations to Bank Accounts- Nat West has advised that the previous offer of compensation has been withdrawn and that the complaint has been dealt with satisfactorily. This was not the opinion of the councillors, however the amount of time and effort involved in pursuing this matter was not deemed worthwhile in view of the derisory amount of compensation offered in the first place. The transfer of accounts to the Yorkshire Bank in Retford continues. Unfortunately due to a clerical error, Cllr Cobb will need to resubmit some papers.

(iv) Street lighting-(see public discussion) Cllr Woodfield to advise clerk of light obscured by trees and to be referred to VIA

(v) Broading Lane-Ongoing

(vi) Electrical Survey-Ongoing.

(vii) Gate on Footpath to Bell Holt & Wharf-Awaiting response. A brief discussion on the Bell Holt and Wharf regarding access. Councillors agreed that gate would remain unlocked until clarification of the path's status and the area of land.

(c) Village Parking-Cllr Collier advised of a number of complaints/comments on parking in the village including restricted access and vision at junctions. Concern was raised over access for emergency vehicles. It was suggested that an article could be submitted to Roundabout highlighting the problems and requesting people take care when leaving their vehicles.
